Little Italy – Mama’s Meatball Recipe

“Mmmm” is the same in every language. So whether you say “mmm” over one of the pizzas we roll and bake on special occasions; or say “mmm” while you sip on our now famous Little Italy Limoncello-Aid; or “mmm” while you enjoy “Mama’s Meatballs” made with herbs fresh from our garden – we know “mmm” translates into every language. Speaking of “Mama’s Meatballs” ... due to several guests asking for the Recipe after they tasted the juicy herb meatballs we serve at Uvongo, we decided to share our secret recipe with you... this one has been passed down for generations!



What You Need For The Yumminess:

- 500g Pork Mince*
- 500g Lean Beef Mince*
- Fresh Herbs (Rosemary, Sweet Basil, Parsley or Origanum) ** Finely Chopped
- Four Cloves of Fresh Garlic, Crushed/ Finely Chopped
- One Large Onion, Diced
- One Cup of Mozzarella or Cheddar Cheese, Grated
- One Large Egg
- One Tin of Tomato and Onion Mix
- One Teaspoon of Brown Sugar
- Dash of Olive Oil
- Salt and Pepper
- Non-Stick Spray

Notes:

* Chicken/Vegetarian mince can be used as substitutes; although we cannot guarantee the same results.

** You can use more than one combination of herbs and use as much as you want.

How To Make the Yumminess:

- 1) Preheat the oven to 180 C.
- 2) Finely chop the basil (about ¾ cups worth); add it to the tin of tomato and onion mix. Add a teaspoon of brown sugar to this and combine. Set half of the mixture aside.
- 3) Take the finely chopped fresh herbs (of choice and amount) and mix it with the mince, garlic, onion, egg, grated cheese and half of the tomato-onion and basil mix. Work together until evenly mixed. Roll into small balls; if it is a hot day you can pop the mince balls in the fridge for a bit.

- 4) Spray an oven pan with non-stick spray; place the meatballs closely together in the pan and drizzle with a dash of olive oil. Bake this in the pre-heated oven for seven to eight minutes; then remove from the oven.
- 5) Evenly pour the remaining tomato-onion and basil mix over the meatballs. And pop it back in the oven, grilling it for three to four minutes. And hey presto! Mama’s Meatballs are ready for you to enjoy!

Recommended: serve with fresh parmesan shavings and additional chopped fresh herbs.



ABOUT THE STORM

“Chi la dura la vince – He who perseveres wins at last”

Earlier this year we discovered the true meaning of “*piove sul bagnato*” or, it doesn’t rain it pours. As you may remember from our mid-year newsletter, our gardens sustained massive damage earlier this year, due to a huge storm in May. This same rainstorm also damaged three of our units (with flat roofs), causing severe leaks; and also damaged the Laundry Room.

But, it takes more than a little storm to discourage “Little Italy”! With the assistance of a professional horticulturalist we designed a new garden, with new plants and special fertiliser. Our newly established garden looks fantastic and is flourishing – and the guests love it. The three units were also fixed by a contractor and our amazing Maintenance Team repaired our Laundry Room. And with that we said “ciao” to that particular storm’s damage.

Unfortunately, that was not the last big storm to hit Uvongo – in June four old trees fell over due to strong winds. Nobody was harmed and we simply removed the trees for our guests’ safety. These winds also affected some of the shade parking bays; but once again we simply made the necessary repairs. So, Uvongo River Resort – two; Hibiscus Coast Storms – zero! Every storm runs out of rain or in the second storm’s case, wind ...eventually.

And while we were busy adding and fixing up at the Resort we thought “safety first, is safety always” and thus added razor wire to secure any potentially vulnerable points on our boundary.
