If you're up for something a little bit adventurous, why not experience the beauty of St Lucia on 🤝 horseback with Bhangazi Horse Safaris – the perfect way to spot zebra, buck, warthogs and wildebeest. Sandy Place guests naturally love going to the beach, or exploring the St Lucia surrounds on foot - particularly on the iGwalagwala Trail, which is an amazing place to spot birds like X fish eagles, kingfisher, terns and herons.

SANDY PLACE'S SECRET ZESTY-BERRY YOGURT BREAD RECIPE At Sandy Place we see you as part of the family! Naturally, we then have no problem sharing our exclusive family recipes with you! So here is one of our best kept secrets – Our Zesty-Berry Yogurt Bread Recipe. Let the holiday tea-time yumminess begin ...

What Do You Need To Make This Yumminess:

- 2 cups of flour
- 1 tsp. of baking powder
- Pinch of salt
- 1 egg, whisked
- 1 cup of fat free milk
- 1/4 cup of butter, melted
- 1 tbsp. of lemon zest
- 1 tbsp. of lemon juice
- $^{3}\!\!\!/$ cup of plain fat free Greek yoghurt (can use normal too)
- 6 tbsps. of sweetner (stevia/xylitol etc.)
- 1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries

Zesty Glaze (Optional):

- ½ cup icing sugar
- 1 tsp. lemon juice
- 2 tsps. fat free milk
- 1 tsp. lemon zest

How Do You Make This Yumminess:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°C. Grease the bottom and sides of 23 x 13 cm (9 x 5 inch) or standard loaf pan.
- Mix the flour, sweetner, baking powder and salt in a large bowl.Once combined, make a well in the centre and set aside.
- 3. Combine the egg, milk, melted butter, lemon zest and lemon juice.

 Pour into the well of dry ingredients. Once well-combined, stir in the yogurt. Gently fold in the blueberries.
- Pour batter into loaf pan and bake for 50 –55 minutes.
 Cool on a wire rack for 10 minutes before removing from pan.
- Zesty Glaze: combine icing sugar with lemon juice, milk and lemon zest.Stir until smooth consistency. Drizzle over warm bread.







IMPORTANT NOTICES

Checking-In Procedures: in the interest of safety, security and ensuring that only confirmed guests are allowed access to the Resort, you will be required to produce both the Reservation Confirmation/Guest Certificate and your ID, and also to complete the Indemnity Form when checking into the Resort.

Guest Certificates: in the event that you are allowing a guest to occupy your timeshare week, the guest must be in possession of a valid Guest Certificate which is obtainable from Head Office prior to the guest's arrival.

Levy Payments: levies must be paid in terms of the Use Agreement and no occupation or usage of any form is allowable until the levies have been paid. This applies to usage, spacebanking, renting etc. of the timeshare week.

Spacebanking and Rentals: please note that a request for spacebanking or rental, must be submitted to Property Admin a minimum of five months prior to the occupation date, to enable us to process. Please contact Property Admin at: propertyadmin@oaks.co.za.

Communication: to enable us to communicate effectively, please ensure that you keep us updated regarding your current contact details, and most importantly, your email address.

Occupation Dates: please note that Resort Calendars are linked to school holidays, and it is therefore vital that you check the Annual Calendar to ensure that you occupy the correct week. Please refer to the 2018 calendar available on the following link:
