Accolades and Accolades – Mabalingwe Shines On:


RCI Annual Awards Ceremony - Not only did Mabalingwe Nature Reserve receive the RADA Award for being

What we've been up to:

Let's kick things off with the many refurbishments and upgrades that have taken place at Mabalingwe! Not a comment, experience or moment go by where we aren't reviewing the Resort to see where, and how, we can make subtle, and big, changes to ensure your home-away-from-home gives you a great experience every, single time!

Fresh Water Aplenty. We recently installed 150 water meters across the property to better manage this precious resource and overall water usage on the Resort. This gives us the opportunity to better assess where improvements can be made, and in which areas.

Wet Towels – The Unwelcome Kiss of the Linen World. We are all too familiar with how it goes. You enjoy a refreshing shower, and the mirrors are all steamy – life is great, and you wrap your dry, clean towel around your body, only to discover that it is not dry and clean, but wet and unwelcoming. No one wants that experience! So we've solved the problem by implementing a plan for 2019; we will be installing more towel hooks on all bathroom doors, as well as new rails outside for swimming towels.

Mirror, mirror on the wall... Mirrors not only help us stay looking our best, but they add another dimension to the room and any space. For this reason we took on a little DIY project of our own and revamped some picture frames, so that the units which needed attention have more mirrors.

Winter Swimming is Sorted! We've opened our suggestions box and listened to what all our guests have to say to get this project up, running and finalised. Another one of our swimming pools, situated next to an existing heated pool, has been converted for warm winter splashing! We hope you enjoy the new heated swimming pool. We appreciate all the feedback we received to make this happen.

A Fresh Coat of Paint. As the days turned into weeks, and the weeks into months, our Kalahari Oasis Pub décor began needing some TLC. A lovely artist, Amanda Clingen, spent some time with us recently to bring our painted elements back to life with her natural flair and paint brush. A Splash of Colour and Art. The Kalahari Oasis Pub wasn't the only thing which received a splash of new paint. Many of our guests mentioned that they wouldn't mind the inclusion of a bit of colour around their home-away-fromhome Resort and we took all these comments to heart, quite literally, and gave the plant pots a lovely makeover – after all, "change is as good as a holiday". We updated the pots with a soft grey and hint of red, while also adding on some steel artwork pieces.

A Word From the Chairman. It was decided that a new sewerage system be built. The magnitude of undertaking this project, for a Resort the size of Mabalingwe can be challenging, but we are well prepared and managed.

"We are in process of replacing our current Sewerage Plant. Our current plant is outdated and is not functioning at optimal levels. As part of this process all the sewerage pipelines are being replaced as well. The new plant will have a lesser impact on the environment and the discharge will be used to create a wetland which should increase birdlife viewing opportunities. The negative to this is unfortunately the cost involved. This cost will however be funded from reserves and no additional levies will have to be raised on our Members." The project commenced in August of this year and will be completed early 2019.

1 Tbsps. Lemon Juice

1 Tsp. English Mustard

Salt, Pepper and Lemon Zest, To Taste


Position: Stock Control Supervisor | Joined us: June 2018


