

A Bit About Uvongo – Do You Know Your Home-Away-From-Home?

At the heart of the Hibiscus Coast, Uvongo is a welcoming town with an unspoilt beach, superb fishing spots, nature reserve, beautiful scenery and so much more. Uvongo is named after the Ivungu River; so named by the Zulu people for the sound of the winds rushing through its steep-sided gorges. The Ivungu is well known for its waterfall that plummets 23 metres, creating one of the deepest lagoons in the country. Uvongo was initially the farm of T.C. Lilliecrona, who, being a surveyor, laid out the new town himself.

Uvongo Beach is sheltered by thick foliage, which grows on the large rock escarpments surrounding the area and is ideal for all water sports. There are pedal boats for hire to enjoy and explore the River more intimately, too. Alongside the River a footpath leads to the Uvongo River Nature Reserve. There is also a lovely children's paddling pool situated on the grassy banks shaded by trees – perfect for a fun, family picnic.

Spend the day relaxing on warm beach sand or snorkel in the refreshing waters that flow and ebb on the shoreline. Friendly hawkers can be found walking the beaches, selling fruit, basketry and crafts.

Perfect-For-The-Beach Bites

Sunny days spent with your toes in the sand, building sandcastles, flying a kite or diving into the waves are some of our favourite beach holiday memories, and what's not to love? Everyone is happy and laughing and warm... Life is good. And so are these "delizioso" mini pita burger bites — made especially for you to pack for a beach day trip!

You will need:

- 1kg of Lean Beef Mince
- 1 Tub of Store-Bought Bread Crumbs
- 1 Diced Red Onion
- 4 Large Eggs
- 180ml Horseradish Sauce
- 1 Punnet Chopped Fresh Parsley
- 30ml Chilli Flakes (Optional)
- 30ml Dried Mint
- Olive Oil (To Taste)
- Salt and Pepper (To Taste)
- 2 Packet of Store-Bought Mini Pita Breads
- · Sauce of Choice
- Fresh Rocket

Let's get cooking!

Preheat the oven to 180°C. Then, you will need to prepare your burger patties. In a large bowl, and using your hands, mix together the mince, bread crumbs, red onion, horseradish sauce, parsley, chilli flakes, mint, salt and pepper as well as a swirl of olive oil. Make sure to mix this mixture well. Now section the patty mixture into small-sized balls, press flat between your palms and place on a greased baking tray or dish. Remember that these patties need to fit into your pita breads! Bake your patties for approximately 15 minutes or until golden and cooked through. Cut pockets into your pita bread and smear a thin layer of your sauce, as well as a little rocket before squeezing a patty into the slit. This recipe will yield approximately 20 mini pita burgers and will store well in an airtight container for up to three days!
