Something Yummy

There is nothing more "Proudly South African" than a braai. Try these delicious braai recipes the next time you visit Little Eden.



Ingredients:

2 tbsp olive oil | 140g long grain rice | 2 garlic cloves, chopped | 350g vegetable stock | Mixed vegetables of choice | 1 bunch spring onions sliced thinly | 140g cherry tomatoes, halved | 150g ball mozzarella, chopped | Handful each of parsley and basil, chopped | 3 red and 3 yellow peppers | String for tying

Method:

- 1. Make the stuffing: heat the oil in a medium pan with a lid and fry the rice until the grains are glossy. Stir in the garlic, then add the stock and bring to the boil. Add mixed vegetables of choice, cover and cook for 10 minutes, until the rice is tender.
- 2. Remove from the heat, cool slightly and stir in the spring onions, cherry tomatoes, mozzarella and fresh herbs. Season well and leave to cool.
- 3. Stuff the peppers: cut around the stalk from one pepper, remove and set aside. Make one slit down the length of the pepper and open out gently. Remove the seeds and membrane. Spoon some filling into the pepper cavity, taking care not to overfill.
- 4. Take about a metre length of kitchen string and wrap the centre point several times around the pepper stalk, tying it firmly.
- 5. Top with the stalk and wrap the ends of the string several times around the pepper to secure the filling. Tie the ends in a knot. Repeat with the other peppers.
- 6. Braai the stuffed peppers over moderate heat for 15-20 minutes, turning gently until the peppers are evenly browned. Don't worry if the string chars and if the peppers split too much wrap them in a piece of foil and finish cooking in the foil wrappers.

Ingredients:

Two rolls of puff pastry | Packet of Marshmallows (enough to braai later) | Slab of Milk Chocolate | Slab of Dark Chocolate | Nut of choice (or substitute with berries) | 2 eggs | Cream or Ice-cream

Method:

- 1. Grease a clean folding grid with a non-stick spray such as spray and cook.
- 2. Unroll one roll of pastry and place on the cold braai grid. Spread the marshmallows, chocolate and nuts evenly on the pastry. A nice thick layer of each should do!
- 3. Unroll the second sheet of pastry and carefully put on top of the filling. Use a fork to seal the edges.
- 4. Use the same fork to whisk the eggs if you do not have a manual whisk.
- 5. Brush the pastry with the whisked egg. Close the grid and braai over moderate coals for 20-30 minutes or until golden brown and done on both sides
- 6. To serve, cut the pie into squares and serve with cream or ice-cream.

Tips

- Place the puff pastry in an oven proof dish and cook over the fire if you do not have a folding grid. Or, Place the puff pastry in an oven proof dish and bake in the oven if the weather isn't suitable for a braai.
- · Swap the nuts for some in-season berries or fruits.
